Slow Roll Race Rules

- Only one person may drive the cart and information must be one to fill out and turn in registration form.
- Up to date license and insurance information must be turned in with this form.
- Carts are expected to follow all local, state and federal laws and ordinances at all times.
- Bikes and carts must be operated in a safe manner for those on board the cart, as well as those in the race and bystanders. Unsafe or dangerous operation will not be tolerated.
- Course maximum speed is 10mph.
- Bikes and carts should never pass the NBPR pace cart.
- Slow roll will begin at 2:55pm from the Macdonald Public Library.
- There will be a dedicated slow roll line to line up in upon arrival.
- Carts may arrive to the library for check-in between 1:30pm and 2:30pm on race day. Carts late to check-in may not be allowed to participate in the roll.
- Carts needing to cross Green St. may do so at the corner of Huntley Ave. & Green St. between 1:30pm and 2:30pm day of, and cross back immediately after the race.
- If you wish to trailer your cart in, you may park at the Aquatic Center (52401 Ashley St.) and ride to the event area.
- Decorating is encouraged! All decorations, music and conduct should be family friendly and without profane language
- In the event of inclement weather, as called by NBPR and NBPD, a full refund will be given within the following 10 business days
- NBPR reserves the right to remove any participant, without refund, due to dangerous operation of the vehicle, as well as inappropriate conduct, music or decorations.
